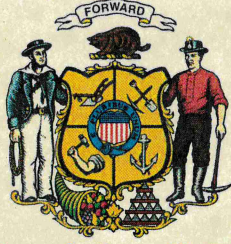

WHEREAS; credit unions offered more than 678,000 hours of free financial counseling last year, helping strengthen Wisconsin citizens' finances; and


WHEREAS; credit unions in Wisconsin work to teach students to save through more than 100 in-school branches and credit unions help families and small business through affordable loans;
